Tim Busch is a businessman, lawyer, and Catholic philanthropist based in Orange County, California. Tim has been married to Steph for 40 years and they have two children, Garrett and Mackenzie, and ten grandchildren, with the eleventh on the way! Tim is the Chairman of the Busch Group, a family of companies that include a law firm, hotel management and development company, winery, and faith based non-profit organizations.

Tim and his wife, Steph Busch have been active members of Legatus since 1990. With Fr Robert Spitzer, S.J., Tim and Steph co-founded the Magis Institute and the Napa Institute. Tim and John Peiffer co-founded the Napa Legal Institute.

As long-time advocates of private Catholic schooling, Tim and Steph co-founded St. Anne Catholic Elementary School in Laguna Niguel, CA in 1992 and JSerra Catholic High School in San Juan Capistrano, CA in 2003. The Catholic University of America, a Pontifical University in Washington, D.C. named its business school the Tim and Steph Busch School of Business and Economics, in recognition of Tim and Steph's generous support of the school.
